



- a. To purchase, consume or possess an alcoholic beverage upon the premises of such establishment between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- b. To be upon the premises of such establishment between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.


Section 3: An alcoholic beverage means any beverage which is unlawful for a person under the age of twenty-one to possess or consume under state or federal law, including those beverages specified in S.C. Code Ann 61-6-20.


Section 4: The times stated herein shall mean Eastern Standard Time, except when Eastern Daylight Savings Time is in effect in the State of South Carolina, the times shall mean Eastern Daylight Savings Time.

Section 5: Upon conviction for violation of this ordinance, the violator shall be fined, imprisoned, or both, up to the maximum fine and/or period of imprisonment which is authorized by state law for the commission of a criminal offense created by county ordinance on the date the violation was committed. Each day a criminal violation occurs shall constitute a separate criminal offense. Each day an infraction occurs shall constitute a separate infraction.

Section 6: If any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such holding shall not affect the constitutionality or validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, the County Council hereby declaring that it would have passed this ordinance, and each and every section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, and word thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more other sections, subsections, paragraphs, subparagraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases, or words hereof may be declared to be unconstitutional, invalid, or otherwise ineffective.
