AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 6.003, PARAGRAPH C OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF ABBEVILLE COUNTY CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS

Pursuant to the authority of Section 4-9-30 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, the South Carolina Constitution and the general law of the State of South Carolina, be it ordained by the County Council of Abbeville County:

I. Amendment of Section 6.003, Paragraph C. Section 6.003, Paragraph C of the Code of Ordinances of Abbeville County is hereby amended by striking the entire text of said paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**6.003 Ordinances and Resolutions.**

**C. Ordinances Other Than Emergency Ordinances.**

1. Ordinances may be introduced by any member of the County Council. All Ordinances must be submitted to the Clerk of Council in writing.
2. The first reading (usually by title only) of the Ordinance shall be recorded in the minutes of the County Council. On first reading of an Ordinance no vote shall be taken and no debate or amendment shall be in order.
3. The second reading of the Ordinance may not be on the same calendar day as the first reading. On second reading a proposed Ordinance may be fully debated, amended, tabled, etc. After discussion, the Ordinance is voted on by Council.
4. Third reading shall take place at least seven calendar days after the second reading of a proposed Ordinance. On third reading, the proposed Ordinance may be acted on in the same manner as for the second reading. If adopted by County Council, the proposed Ordinance becomes an official Ordinance.

5. The Clerk of Council shall be responsible for indexing and providing for compilation of the adopted Ordinance in the County Code.

6. The Clerk of Council shall cause a copy of the adopted Ordinance to be filed in the Office of the Clerk of Court. A record of such filing shall be maintained by the Clerk of Council.

II. Time Effective. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption on Third Reading.
