APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Councilman Davis made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 8, 2006, regular county council meeting. Councilman Calhoun seconded the motion. The motion carried 6-0-1 with Councilman Thomas abstaining.

- 2) A resolution (06-33) providing for the expenditure of accounts payable from the Infrastructure Development Fund for development of the county's GIS System during the fiscal year. Councilman Thomas made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilman Norris seconded the motion. The motion carried 7-0-0.
