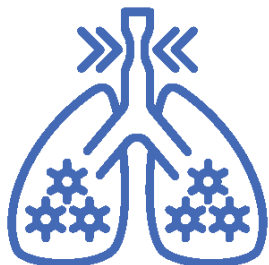

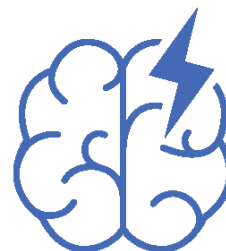
## CALL 911 IF YOU:



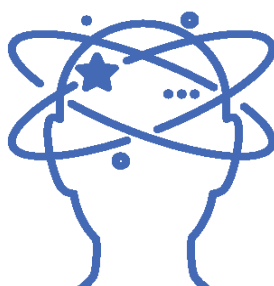
HAVE DIFFICULTY  
BREATHING / CHOKING



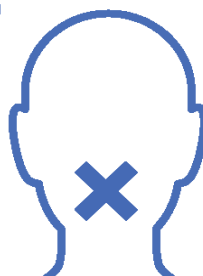
HAVE AN ALLERGIC
